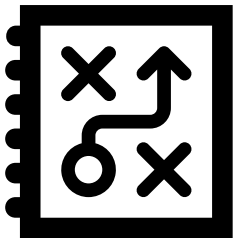
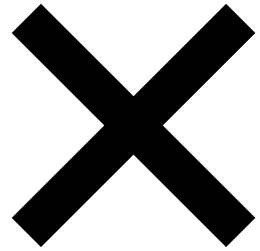

Senate Bill 22 Impacts

- > R.C. 3707.54 & R.C. 3709.50
 - "...Any order or regulation that applies to a class of persons in violation of this section is invalid and has no legal effect."
- > Rescinded
 - Regulations 101 & 102
- > Amended
 - Regulations 100, 106 & 199

Private vs. Public Nuisance

- > Does the condition affect the property
 - Above?
 - Below?
 - Adjacent?

- > Health Nuisances
 - Breeding areas and harborage for vectors
 - Mosquitoes, cockroaches, rats
 - Collection of sewage
 - Open dumping
 - Conditions “dangerous to life or health” R.C. 3707.01
