

Franklin County Township Association

Meeting Minutes 9/9/2021

President Chet Chaney opened the meeting at 6:03 p.m. Franklin County Engineer Cornell Robertson led the Pledge of Allegiance. Treasurer Ron Grossman gave the Treasurer's Report and indicated that membership included 68 active townships at that time. OTA approved a new category to include affiliate employees which would need to be approved at the annual meeting. Motion to approve the Treasurer's report was made by Laura Kunze of Sharon Township with a second by Rich Courter of Jefferson Township.

Secretary Laura Kunze presented meeting minutes from the April 8, 2021, meeting. Motion to approve those minutes was made by Ron Grossman of Jackson Township with a second by Nancy White of Mifflin Township.

Joe Martin presented about an upcoming survey for the 2022 meeting to solicit feedback on logistics, topics, timing. The survey will take under 5 minutes to complete and planned deployment in mid-late September.

Nancy White presented about the SWACO appointment. Resumes are needed for this 2-year appointment by Sept 20th. The townships would need to pass a resolution and then the successful appointee would be submitted to SWACO.

The Franklin County Engineers office discussed how motor vehicle registration fees are down 50%, gas tax revenues 29%. 70+ projects were underway currently. 2022 will see the largest capital improvement ever coming in at \$32 million. Nick Soulas' new role with the Franklin County Engineer's Office was introduced.

Niki Lemin with Franklin County Public Health presented about SB22 and its impact on public health mandate authority.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:42 p.m. with a motion by Nancy White and second by Joe Martin.
