**Thursday, May 16, 2019, 6:30 pm**  
**Meeting Minutes**

The meeting was called to order at 6:50 pm by President Chet Chaney. Minutes from the March 21, 2019 meeting were presented by Secretary Laura Kunze. Motion to accept by Mike Craig, seconded by Lynn Stewart. All ayes and no nays.

Treasurer Ron Grossman presented the treasurer's report and reported that OTA dues were due end of June, membership invoices went out.

Niki Lemin from the Franklin County Health Department discussed financial assistance for failing septic systems at myfcph.org. Eileen Leuby from MORPC discussed a weatherization program for Franklin County residents.

Attorney Peter Griggs presented on the Transportation Bill, a permissive registration tax (ORC 4504.181) and the process to opt in, including 2 public hearings, resolution adoption at the 2<sup>nd</sup> public hearing, deadline of July 1 delivery to Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles.

Joe Garrity, Director of Governmental Affairs, Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission, further discussed the Transportation Bill and that a potential revenue spreadsheet will be provided.

Marissa Myers, Director of Governmental Affairs, Ohio Township Association, discussed that 34% of roads are maintained by townships, but only 6% of funding is allocated to townships.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:34 pm with a motion by Mike Craig, seconded by Lynn Stewart.
