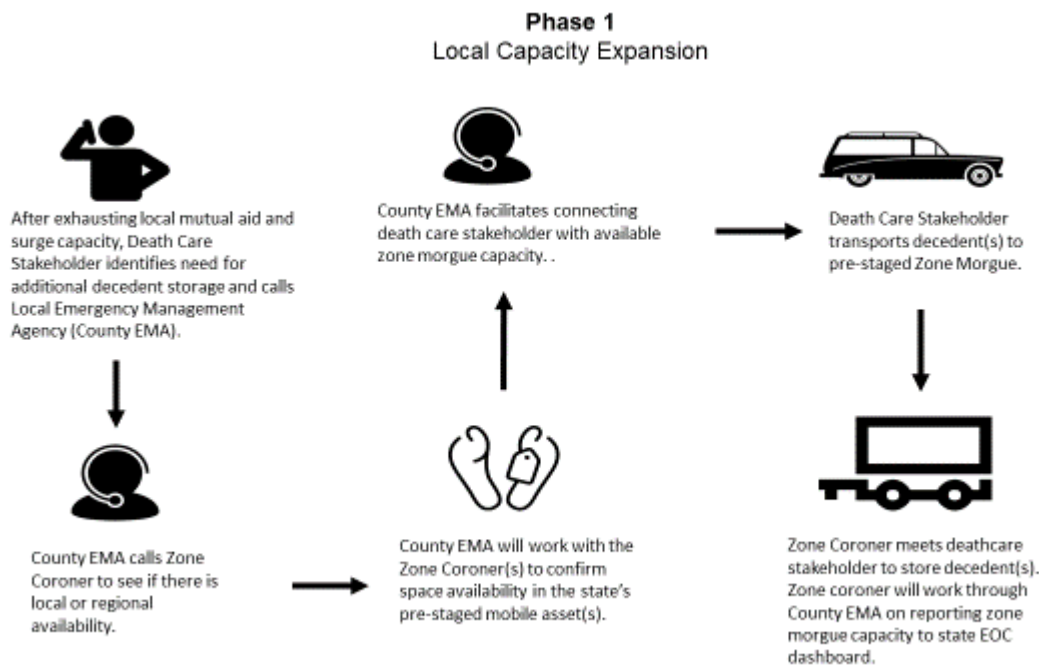

## State of Ohio COVID-19 Fatality Management Response Plan: Phases 1 & 2

### Phase 1

Local Capacity Expansion: Local entities involved with death care (funeral homes, coroners, and hospitals) may have limited storage capacities. Most death care locations routinely operate with the ability to support small scale storage or acute incidents. Prolonged incidents, including pandemics, may exhaust storage capacities. Deathcare stakeholders should communicate with their Zone Coroners when their internal storage capacity reaches 70% capacity so that they may start planning for internal capacity expansion or external partner engagement.



**Pre-planning:** In preparation for a potential fatality surge, ensure you have pre-planned:

- Site for a storage container.
- Security.
- Transportation.
- Staffing.
- Resources.
- **County EMA:** Your County EMA is your first contact to support requests for resources, including state-vented mobile cooling units and refrigerated trailers. To receive support in an efficient manner, you must make requests promptly to your County EMA. Additionally, situational awareness is essential to allow your County EMA and the State to be aware of potential surges. Given the limited number of resources and the potential surge in fatalities across the state, provide your County EMA more than 72 hours of notice when your jurisdiction requires expanded decedent storage.

### State Resources

There are three different decedent storage resources.

- **53-foot refrigerated semitrailer, requires:**
  - o Capacity without racks: 24 decedents
  - o Capacity with racks: 72 decedents
- **40-foot refrigerated shipping container, requires:**
  - o Capacity without racks: 18 decedents
  - o Capacity with racks: 54 decedents
- **24-foot mobile morgue, requires:**
  - o Capacity without racks: 18 decedents

*\*Site security is the responsibility of the locality. Security entails providing a secure site (e.g., fencing) and staff security, as needed.*

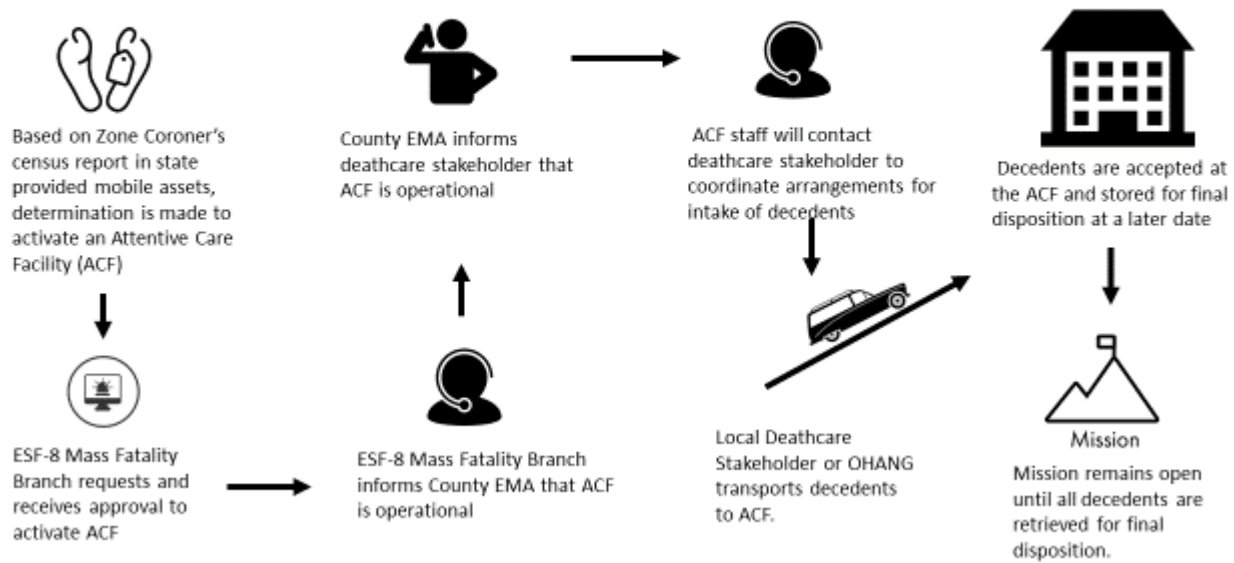

## State of Ohio COVID-19 Fatality Management Response Plan: Phases 1 & 2

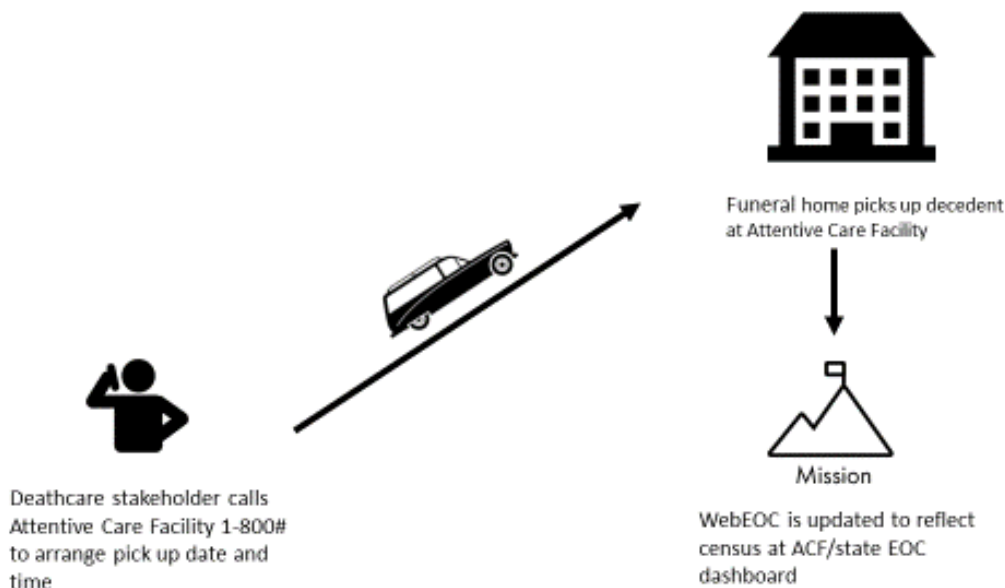
### Phase 2

Attentive Care Facilities: An Attentive Care Facility (ACF) is a designated storage space equipped to temporarily hold decedent remains when local-level decedent storage capacities are exceeded during a worse-case scenario mass fatality event.
